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Purple Word Review

Purple Words are used when longer sentences have too many images to add. **Purple words reduce sentence images for a final translation.**

Remember: Readers can quickly process only 3-4 images at the same time.

Directions:

1. The reader places **purple words** (*nouns/gerunds or adjectives*) at the end of a group of words or phrase.
2. Verify that the **purple words** umbrella each group of words.
3. Add all **purple words** to translate the sentence.
4. Verify the sentence (1-7).
 - **Once this procedure is learned, the reader will be using purple words automatically in his/her head.**

Example:

1. The Warner/ family/ **WARNERS** lives/ in/ an apartment/ **APARTMENT** and found /a mouse/**MOUSE** in/ a bedroom/ area/**SMALL** that is not/ wide open. / **>CLOSED**

The reader adds:

**Warner + Apartment + Mouse + Small + Closed (or partially closed) =
The mouse is in the bedroom closet.**
