Advanced Purple Word Review

Advanced Purple Word is used when complex sentences have too many **purple words** to add for a final translation. **Advanced Purple word reduces purple word images.**

- **Remember: Readers can quickly process only 3-4 images (whether textual or purple words) at the same time.**
- **Advanced Purple Word combines 2-4 purple words from multiple purple word images, or, after punctuation. Two advanced purple words can also be combined into a “what does what” or “what is what.”**
- **Advanced purple word will eventually become automatic in the reader’s head.**
- **The maximum amount of purple words for complex sentences is 4 (including combined advanced purple words).**
⇒ **Complex sentences are in reading material with 5-6 lines of text per sentence.**

Example:

Note that **purple words** are either **bolded black** (to keep the integrity of the sentence) or in **light purple**. **Advanced purple words** are in **dark purple**.

Original sentence: Soldiers do not march in unison across bridges because they could cause mechanical resonance—a vibration that creates a force strong enough collapse what appears to be a solid and immovable bridge; an object at the same frequency as the object’s natural frequency can amplify the vibration of the object and cause it to collapse from the movement.

Soldiers do not march in unison **XSAME** across **bridges** because they could cause **mechanical resonance**—a vibration that creates a **force** strong enough collapse what appears to be a solid and immovable bridge **BREAKDOWN UNISON>COLLAPSING** ; an object at the same **frequency IDENTICAL** as the object’s **natural** frequency can amplify **INCREASING** the **vibration** of the object and cause it to collapse from the movement **COLLAPSING SAME^VIBRATION** .

POSSIBLE TRANSLATIONS:

Marching in unison across a bridge can make the bridge collapse.

Mechanical resonance can make a bridge collapse.
